## GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### ARTICLE 1: PURPOSE:

The present terms and conditions govern the relationship between the organiser of the event and the partner who has signed a purchase order for a VIP package. The present terms and conditions complete the information found on the organiser's website [www.mastersgrandslam.com](http://www.mastersgrandslam.com) and prevail in case of contrariety. Any particular condition granted to the partner will be included in the purchase order.

### ARTICLE 2: SCOPE OF THE PURCHASE ORDER:

Signing the LONGINES HONG KONG MASTERS purchase order binds the partner irrevocably. The partner must use his or her reservation personally, and cannot transfer or sub-lease his rights. Under no circumstances can he or she sell them to any travel agency, sports or cultural events organiser, or any other service provider. The signature on the purchase order is supposed to be made by the person authorised to obligate the legal person entity, where a legal entity exists. Without definitively engaging he/she who signs, the person who has signed the purchase order will be held personally, jointly and indivisibly liable to the commitments in said order. In the case of a withdrawal by the partner, whatever the reason may be, even if the totality of available tickets is not hired, the partner will be held liable for 100% of the total amount of the package if the withdrawal or the cancellation is received 14 days before the event, 50% if the cancellation is received four weeks before the event, 10% if the cancellation is received more than a month before the event. Any instalment paid shall be retained; the remaining amount will be claimed. The organiser is sole decider of the admission of the people accompanying the partner, without having to justify the decision.

### ARTICLE 3: INVOICING AND PAYMENT:

Any invoice from the organiser is payable in full. The Headquarters of the organising company can be held accountable for said invoice. The non-payment of an invoice at the due date will automatically result ipso jure and with no prior notice in the charging of a conventional interest of 12% per annum, as well as a compensation amounting to 10% of the unpaid amount. The prices expressed on the purchase order being exclusively expressed in HKD and excluding taxes, the payment to be made exclusively by bank transfer on the account indicated on the purchase order. In the eight days following signature of the purchase order, the organiser will issue a pro forma invoice, which shall be regarded as a confirmation of the order, payment to be made at reception of this document. After reception of payment only, shall a definite invoice issued by the organiser be sent. The documents enabling access on the site will be sent only after reception of the payment of balance. In the case of payment of the invoice more than a month after it has been sent, the organiser reserves the right to cancel the order and sell the package to a third party. The difference between the product of the sale of the VIP package to a third party and the initially sold price will be invoiced to the VIP partner who hasn't fulfilled his or her obligations.

### ARTICLE 4: FORTUITOUS EVENT OR FORCE MAJEURE, CANCELLATION OF THE EVENT OF ANY NATURE:

If, either because of a fortuitous event or force majeure, or for any other reason, it is impossible for the organiser to organise his event, the organiser reserves the right either to postpone the event, or to cancel it, without the partner being entitled to claim any damages whatsoever. In the case of total or partial cancellation of the event for any reason whatsoever (catastrophes, flooding, fires, strikes, mobs, etc... or security or any reason beyond or within the organiser's control), no amount can be demanded from the organiser, who will be entitled to keep any sum already paid by the VIP partner who will not be entitled to claim any refund, exchange, or compensation, or entitled to any legal recourse.

### ARTICLE 5: RESPONSABILITY:

The partner is committed to respect all rules, security instructions, orders and policy in force within the event area, and to make sure his guests, partners, representatives, etc ... also respect said rules. The organiser reserves the right to refuse access and/or exclude any person whose attire or behaviour might jeopardise the smooth functioning of the event, or whose behaviour could affect the organiser's interests, or who wouldn't respect the regulations and instructions. The partner waives any claims on this count. The partner discharges the organiser from any contractual or tort liability or any other liability in the framework of the organisation of the event and of any accident which could occur to him or the people he invited, partners, representatives, etc.... The partner will therefore be solely responsible for any accidents caused by these people or to these people and to his or her possessions, as well as theirs. They therefore waive any and all claims against the organiser and the other partners. The organiser invites therefore the partner to cover his or her liability. The partner authorises the organiser to use any footing on which himself/herself, his or her partners, guests, representatives could appear, in any possible way, photographs, films, etc ... on the occasion of the organisation of the LONGINES HONG KONG MASTERS, on any support and in any media and therefore transferable in the entire world for publicity and/or representation purposes, as well as for broadcasting rights.

### ARTICLE 6: THE ORGANISER:

The organiser shall not be held liable for the loss of the invitations and documents enabling access once said documents have been sent to the partner. In order to obtain new accreditations, an invoice for the amount of the purchase order will once more be issued. In order to access the event sites, the partner or his or her guests or representatives must be in possession of their invitation. The organiser has exclusive rights for food and beverage supplying, which he has sub-contracted by exclusive catering. Therefore, the partner shall not deal with any other supplier than the one delegated by the organiser, and therefore shall not introduce any food or beverage on the event premises. The organiser has exclusive rights for publicity on the event site, therefore the partner shall not be allowed to label, distribute or display any advertising mention whatsoever or any support whatsoever without the express written and prior authorisation from the organiser. The organiser will provide temporary washrooms and mobiles lavatories. The organiser will endeavour to provide the services described in his offers or visible on his website, but shall not be liable for any compensation if he should modify any service from his brochure or in his offer.

### ARTICLE 7: APPLICABLE LAW AND JURISDICTION:

The agreement concluded by the signing of the purchase order, of which the present terms & conditions are nominally a part, shall be exclusively subject to the law of Hong Kong. Any dispute relating to performance or interpretation or any conflict between parties will be solely under the jurisdiction of the courts of Hong Kong, applying Hong Kong law, the organiser reserving the right to choose any other competent court.

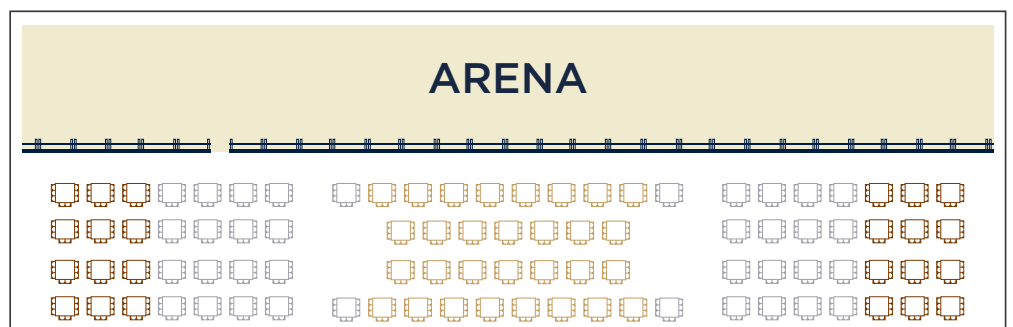
